WHEN DOES THE SEASON BEGIN & END?

The first class will be on February 5th and the last class will be April 30th. There will be no class on March 26th for spring break.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENT

All Preschool Dancers must be at least 3 years-old by February 5, 2022 and must be potty trained before enrolling for class. We highly recommend that your dancer is enrolled in a preschool prior to registration in order to enhance their learning while in their dance class.



WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT YOUR CHILD TO LEARN?

Our goal in preschool class is for each child to enjoy their time in dance class while teaching the fundamentals that will prepare them for the next level of classes. Dancers begin to learn the basics of Ballet and Jazz while exploring their own creativity. Working on balance, rhythm, musicality, and proper classroom expectations help the dancers understand the concentration necessary to grow as a dancer. Dancers will attend a one-hour class which will be divided into 30 minutes of ballet and 30 minutes of jazz. Dancers will be responsible for bringing a bag with both pairs of shoes and will change their shoes on their own as a part of learning independence.

OUR MISSION

We truly believe that our youngest dancers are capable of anything. Instilling the foundations of good technique within our youngest dancers is imperative when training strong dancers. Developing a curriculum that implements these foundations all while allowing these tiny dancers to explore and love dance is the main focus of our Preschool Program.

PREPARING FOR CLASS

There are a few things you can do to help our class run smoothly and maximize our dancing time.

Please arrive 5 minutes before class starts. Parents and families will be able to enter the lobby and stay for the first 5 minutes of class if they desire. Parents will also be able to enter the lobby for the last 5 minutes of their dancer's class. For our dancers' safety, the doors will be locked in between each class. Please make sure your dancer uses the bathroom prior to arriving at the studio.

We will start each class with ballet, so you can have your child's ballet shoes on and they may bring in their jazz shoes, preferably in a bag. As part of the preschool class we would like to instill a sense of responsibility in each dancer, therefore we will encourage them to change their shoes on their own during class. This may take some time for the first couple of weeks, but soon enough they will all get it. We love to see them so proud of accomplishing it on their own!

The only thing in your dancer's bags should be their jazz shoes and the sticker book they will receive on their first day of class. Please have your dancer arrive wearing ballet shoes. Also, please label all shoes with your child's name on the inside of the shoe.



REQUIRED ATTIRE & SHOES

FEMALE DANCERS

ATTIRE

Black leotard and pink convertible tights.

No costumes, skirts, or dresses.

Hair must be pulled back in a bun with a hairnet and bobby pins.

SHOES

Pink Leather Full Sole Ballet Shoes AND Tan Leather Half Ballet Shoes

MALE DANCERS

ATTIRE

Above the knee shorts and form-fitted t-shirt/tank top.

Must be black or white.

SHOES

Black Leather Full Sole Ballet Shoes AND Black Split Sole Jazz Shoes



STUDIO POLICIES

ATTIRE EXPECTATION AND REQUIREMENTS

As a studio, we implement a specific dress code to benefit each dancer enrolled in our program. Not only is it a safety issue when dancers aren't dressed properly, but it also lowers the level of professionalism in the class when dressed improperly. Having strict guidelines for these requirements will only enhance your dancer's experience. It is vital that these expectations are met every week, and should any complications occur, we kindly ask that you notify us in the office via email or phone call.

TARDINESS

Students will not be permitted into class after 15 minutes of class start time unless the administration is notified in a timely manner.

LOBBY RULES

Parents will be able to enter the lobby 5 minutes before and after the beginning of class. For example, if your child's class begins at 9:30am the lobby will be open from 9:25am-9:35am. For our dancers' safety, the doors will be locked in between each class.

ONLINE PAYMENTS

All clients have the ability to sign up for autopay, free of charge, to eliminate late fees. Tuition fees can be paid through your online account. There will be no refunds or prorated tuition rates under any circumstances.

MISSED CLASSES/MAKEUP CLASSES

Makeup classes are unavailable at this time. No refunds or credits will be issued for any missed classes.

CLASS CANCELLATION

If removal/cancellation from a class is needed, email notification must be sent before the 20th of the month to prevent charges for the following month. If you do not request to be removed from the class before the 20th, you will be charged for that class regardless of whether your child can attend. Studio 61 Dance Company will credit your dance account for the amount due if your child does not attend. Studio 61 Dance Company would not refund or credit any funds if written confirmation in an email was not sent via email before the 20th.
